51/11 Declarations of Interest

52/11 Election of Chair

Resolved - that Mr K Harrison be elected as Chairperson for the ensuing year.

53/11 Public Participation

54/11 Playing Pitch Strategy

Members completed the document for return.

55/11 Work at Kitswell Park

Members were informed that works to tidy the entrance to Kitswell Park Bike track and play area had been undertaken. The works involved the removal of concrete posts and wire fencing, pruning of bushes / trees, clearing the ground, applying topsoil and planting a hedge. The works were undertaken following approval at a council meeting in July 2010.

56/11 Manor Grange Play Area

The play area at Manor Grange was discussed following referral to the Recreation Committee last year. The play area currently has a slide and two sets of swings. Members discussed the current financial situation and potential costs.

Resolved - that no development takes place unless funding can be secured

57/11 Leases
