County Durham Environment Awards 2013

The Lanchester Village Green Project was awarded a Commendation at the recent Environment Awards Ceremony at the Radisson Blu Hotel in Durham in October.

The Village Green project was undertaken in two stages and was completed last year. The project included the installation of a new path, tree planting, tree works, drainage works, planting native flower bulbs, hedge laying, creation of wildlife habitats, litter bin and seat replacement and the installation of wood carvings.

The Environment Awards aim to reward great design, environmental guardianship and community spirit in County Durham. The project was considered by the Environment Awards panel this year and awarded a commendation.

The project was made possible due to funding from CDENT, Northern Gas Networks, Lanchester Parish Council, Lanchester Dairies and Lanchester Wine Cellars Ltd

Lanchester Parish Council were thrilled to receive the award in recognition of the project.

The schools have agreed the times and content for their banner workshops which will be delivered by Durham Bannermakers. Discussions currently taking place with the schools to agree a timetable for the dance workshops which will be delivered by Aubrey O' Brien in the New Year.
