Welcome to Lanchester Parish Council's newsletter. This newsletter is produced quarterly to provide the community with information on the services and activities that the Council provides.

#### **WW1 Beacons of Light**

In commemoration and remembrance of the end of the war and the many millions who were killed or came home dreadfully wounded, 1000 Beacons of Light will be lit at 7pm on 11 November 2018 throughout the United Kingdom, Channel Islands, Isle of Man and UK Overseas Territories - a century after the guns fell silent.

Lanchester Parish Council are working in partnership with Burnhope Parish Council to light a beacon as part of the WW1 Beacons of Light Event.



The Beacon will be located on high ground at the picnic area between Burnhope and Lanchester Parish.

We are currently seeking advice from the County Councils Safety Advisory Group to progress the event.

Further details of the event including exact location and how to attend will be provided later in the year.

#### **Lanchester Neighbourhood Plan**

A working group of the Parish Council including representatives from community organisations and individuals have been working for a considerable amount of time to develop the Lanchester Neighbourhood Plan.

The plan is reaching its final stage of development and the draft document is now being written. The community will get a chance to respond to the draft document with further community consultation being planned later this year.

Once the document is finalised a referendum will take place to vote on the plan.

#### Village Green War Memorial

The Parish Council and members of the community are working on a project to have the names of fallen soldiers added to the Village Green War Memorial. The works are planned to be completed in time for the 100 year commemoration of the end of WW1 in November.

A company has been appointed to undertake the work and the design of the war memorial has been agreed. Work continues on the important task of checking the list of names for inclusion to ensure that it is complete and accurate. The project has been made possible through a grant of £9,500.00 from the County Council Neighbourhood Budget. The Parish Council have also committed funds to enable the project to progress.

#### Park House Play Area

Planned maintenance and refurbishment works will take place at Park House Play Area from the middle of June.

The works include the replacement of the safety surfacing in the main play area, replacement of some of the equipment and painting of play equipment.

The necessary works are scheduled to be completed before the busy summer holiday period.

The work which has been organised in conjunction with Durham County Council will cost approximately £27,000 with the monies being provided through a fund held by the County Council with a £9,500 contribution from the Parish Council.

We look forward to a refurbished play area and hope the community enjoy the improved facilities.
