268/19 Manor Grange Play Area

Members were presented with the results of the resident's survey undertaken in September / October on the Manor Grange and Deanery View estates. The survey aimed to ascertain demand for the proposed play area and asked for comments on the proposals.

Forty responses had been received with 5 responses expressing concerns or objections to the proposals. The majority of the responses were positive with enthusiastic comments for the project. Responses indicated well over a hundred children who would use the play area.

Members considered the full content of the responses.

Members considered that the survey had generated a good response with a majority in favour of the project. They were however mindful of the concerns raised.
